

Finally we will be looking at friends, family and relationships. We will use role play to allow children to explore different strategies of being a good friend and the difficulties they may have with friends. We will think about different types of relationships using circle time to discuss thoughts, opinions and questions of friends, boyfriends/ girlfriends and marriage.

All of the above areas will be taught through careful discussions and activities, where the children's self-esteem goes hand in hand with accurate information as well as where/ when they can go to get more information at their level. Our aim is to ensure the children grow up to be able to be proud, confident, happy children who know it is ok to ask for help and advice.



St George's PSHE curriculum 2016



During this term we are going to be learning about how we can be healthy, how we can make (and keep) friends, how we grow up and change as well as how we can keep ourselves safe.

At St George's Primary School, we aim to teach the children about themselves, their surroundings, who they can turn to for advice and how to make good choices. Below are some examples of the areas we will be covering. If you have any questions, please feel free to come and talk to the class teachers who will be able to discuss the lessons in more detail.

Year 2

We will be using 'circle time' and role play to discover the children's knowledge of drugs and medicines. We will discuss the reasons why people use medicines and how they are distributed through prescriptions. The children will understand that all medicines are drugs and they can help you when you are ill. Children will begin to understand that not all drugs are medicines and these can be harmful. The children will also think about the safety aspects of medicine and that taking someone else's medicine can be harmful. We will look at the choices that some people choose to make such as smoking tobacco and drinking alcohol.

We will also be recognising the different emotions that we feel and those feelings of others. Using role play children will explore how they help and support others.

The children will be made aware about reproduction in terms of their family e.g. new babies in the family. Children will understand a baby takes nine months to develop and through role play begin to realise that babies need a lot of care. During this children will also explore, through stories, families and understand that families can be very different.

We will look at our personal safety, where the children can discuss safe environments and people who could help them. We will discuss the term 'stranger' and will understand the term. The children will learn the difference between what feels comfortable and uncomfortable.

The children will look at how they need to respect the needs, feelings and opinions of others. We will use stories and role play to understand and think about why bullying is unacceptable.
