Educational Visit to London 12th June 2017

Following very successful educational visits in 2013 and 2015 we have once again been given the fantastic opportunity to take our older children for a tour of the Houses of Parliament. The visit will take place on Monday 12th June. The children will be accompanied by staff including Mr. Fell, Mrs. Beeden, Mrs Ruddy and Mrs. Perrin-Brown.

In addition to the guided tour of the Houses of Parliament the children will receive many educational experiences, including a flight on The London Eye, supporting their work in Geography/History & Science and a visit to the Globe Theatre, supporting their work in Shakespearian Literature. Our aim is that such an exciting visit will bring the children's education to life.

The itinerary for the visit is as follows: -

- Leave school at approximately 6.30 am
- Houses of Parliament at 10.00 a.m. lasting approximately one hour.
- Globe Theatre - Tour and Exhibition
- Lunch
- London Eye
- Coach pick up at 4.30 p.m.
- Coach back at school, traffic permitting, between 7.30 – 8.00 p.m.

The cost of the visit will be approximately £35.00 per child. An initial non-refundable deposit of £10 should be paid by 27th March with the final amount to be paid by Friday 19th May. This is a very good rate due to the group booking. As many of you are aware there will be no residential visit this year as these take place in alternate years. This is the main visit of the year for your child. We are happy to accept payments on a weekly basis if this helps. Please return the slip below together with the deposit as soon as possible in order that we can confirm the booking. Please speak to Mrs Griffiths if the money would prevent your child going on the visit. We hope as many of the children as possible will be able to go, however if there are insufficient funds we may need to consider cancelling the visit.

Depending on 'take up' of places there could be a few spare seats on the coaches and if any parent would like to have a 'day out' in London we can offer a place on the coach for £15. You will be dropped off by the Houses of Parliament at about 10.00 a.m. and must be back at the London Eye Car Park for the coach to pick you up by 4.30 p.m.
