Decimals

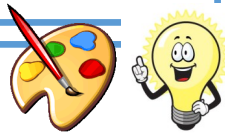
Dividing one and two digit numbers by 100.

Children celebrate achievements of the 'Amazing Egyptians'. They explore 20th Century minimalistic music inspired by the story of Akhenaten.

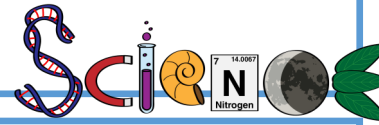

Hockey

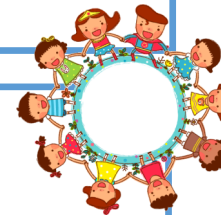
Children will focus on key skills such as dribbling, passing, receiving and intercepting the ball. This unit will also develop other important skills like collaboration, decision making and working safely with a team.
