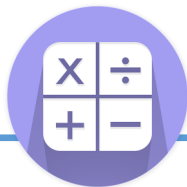

Maths

Time

Converting between analogue and digital times and using a 24 hour clock format.

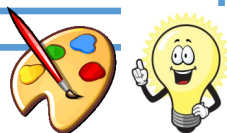
Shape

Comparing and sorting angles in shape and finding lines of symmetry.

Children will learn a basic biscuit recipe and adapt it to suit a target audience.



Geography/History

What are rivers and how are they used?

Learning about rivers; their place in the water cycle, the name and location of major rivers and how they are used.



Music

Compose

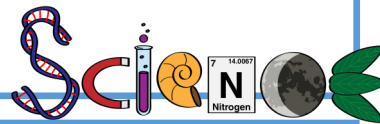
Compose simple tunes using a pentatonic scale and improvise repeated patterns (ostinato).



Science

Animals and humans.

Children continue to learn about the digestive system and teeth. They will interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.



Computing

We use Scratch to identify repeated instructions and using shortcuts to code this information (loops) we progress to creating infinite loops.



PE

Athletics

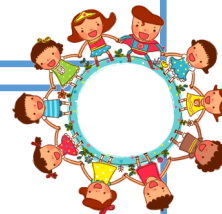
Children will develop basic running, jumping and throwing techniques. They will learn to think how to achieve the greatest speed, distance or accuracy.
Swimming—Children will work towards learning lifesaving techniques, variety of strokes and swim 25m.



PSHE

Changing Me

Children will learn about how their bodies are changing and what happens as they grow.



Spanish

Children will be learning to talk about their holidays. They will identify what they will need to pack in their suitcases and describe the weather.



English

Focusing on the text; Hello Lighthouse by Sophie Blackall.

Children will use previous knowledge of expanded noun phrases and personification to write a descriptive paragraph describing an atmosphere and tension.

Poetry

Children will create their own poem with a theme of mystery based on the poem 'The Listeners' by Walter De La Mere.
