Year 4 Autumn Term 1 on a page

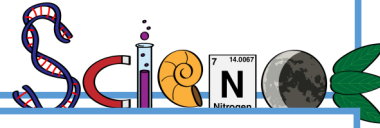


Maths: Place value and Addition and Subtraction.

We will be representing and partitioning numbers to 10,000. This will include ordering, comparing and rounding numbers. We will also be adding and subtracting four-digit numbers and learning strategies to check our work.

Science: Grouping and classifying living things.

We will be learning about how we can group animals and plants. This will include vertebrates and invertebrates and using classifying keys to investigate how different animals and plants with similar characteristics.



Computing: Coding

Children will explore 2code to add different parts of coding including control actions, planning algorithms and changing attributes of objects.



Art: Drawing- Power prints

We will be exploring drawing and shading with different sorts of pencils, creating artwork with wax resist materials and making out prints.



Geography: Who lives in Antarctica?

We will locate the key physical and human characteristics of Antarctica and use lines of longitude and latitude to find different areas on the globe. We will use Shackleton's journey to plot out our own routes on maps.



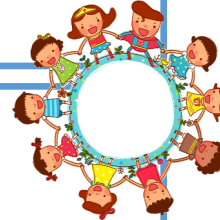
PE: Swimming and Gymnastics

We will be swimming and develop balancing, rolling, jumping and inverted movements in gymnastics.



PSHE: Being me in my world.

We will be learning about the rights and responsibilities of being a citizen in our community, class, school and world. We think about how our actions affect others.



Music-Singing in Spanish

Children will learn songs in Spanish and sing with accompaniments. They will perform repeating rhythms using percussion.



Spanish- My town

We will be learning to describe places in a town and give our address in Spanish. We will be learning to count to 100 in Spanish and finding out about cultural differences in Spain.



English: Greta and the Giants by Zoe Tucker and Last by Nicola Davies

We will be reading Greta and the Giants and writing fact files about Greta Thunberg.

We will be writing non-chronological reports about extinct animals using headings, subheadings and technical vocabulary. We will be focusing on ensuring we understand lots of the grammar for Year 4 too!

RE: Why do we celebrate.

We will be learning about celebrations from different religions and the reasons for these including remembrance Sunday, Christian confirmation, celebration of a new baby in different faiths and Jewish Shabbat. We will learn to compare and contrast different celebrations and explore the importance for those that celebrate.
