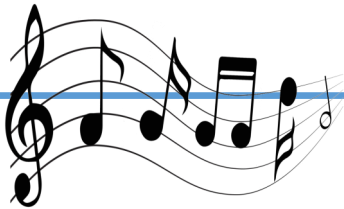
Understanding the World

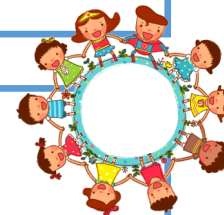
Physical Development
