Maths

We will start the term by learning to recognise, order and compare numbers to 50. After that we will be learning to measure the length, height, mass and volume of different objects.

Art

In Art we will be using paper to make 3D sculptures using techniques such as rolling and shaping strips of paper.



Geography/History

This term's big question is 'What is the weather like in the UK?' We will be learning about the seasons and observing weather patterns.



Music

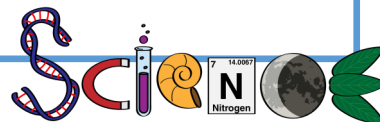
In Music we will explore clapping along to repeated words and phrases, creating rhythmic patterns to tell a familiar fairytale.

Science

We will start the term learning to identify common animals and learning which are carnivores, herbivores or omnivores. Then we will look at seasonal changes in springtime by exploring the changes we see in our school grounds.



Computing

We will be grouping and organising data and labelling the groups we have made.



PE

This term the children will be developing their ball skills including throwing and catching.



PSHE

The topic this term is called 'Healthy Me'. The children will be thinking about how to stay happy, healthy and safe.



English

In Year One we will be reading the story of 'Traction Man is Here' by Mini Grey. We will discuss Traction Man and think about what makes him a hero.

We will then write a non-chronological report about Traction Man using headings and technical language.



RE

In RE we will be continuing to learn about the Islamic faith. We will think about how Muslims express their beliefs and which celebrations are important to them. We will learn about the importance of Ramadan to Muslims and how Eid al-Fitr is celebrated.
