Maths:

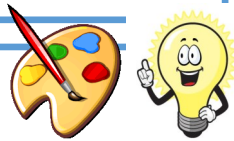
Number and place value: Children will describe, partition and compare numbers up to 1 million.

Addition and subtraction: Children will learn mental methods before adding and subtracting numbers of more than 4 digits.

Children will explain where the Vikings came from and why they invaded Britain. They will sequence events and find evidence and make inferences from sources.



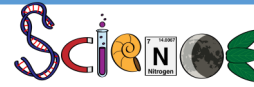
Computing: Quizzing

Science: Space



Children will learn about different forces. They will find out about friction, air resistance, water resistance and gravity. Along the way they will be planning and completing investigations about air and water resistance.

PE: Football

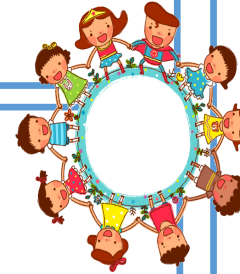


Children will learn how to play this team game. They will develop skills in running, dribbling, passing, shooting, defending and receiving the ball.

Badminton: Children will develop their racket skills. They will select and apply skills and tactics to play competitively.

PSHE: Being me in my world:

Children will talk about what they value about school and identify their hopes for this school year. They will recognise differences and similarities between themselves and others



Music: Composition notation Ancient Egypt

Identifying the pitch and rhythm of written notes and experimenting with notating their compositions in different ways to help develop their understanding of staff notation.

Year 5 Grammar - Children will revise previous grammar and be introduced to the new grammar for Year 5. This will then be used across the year.



Narrative - Arthur and the Rope. - Children will write a heroic pursuit story based on a Viking character on a quest to solve a problem.
