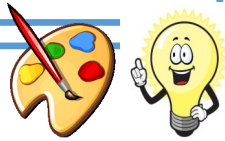
### Maths:

**Multiplication and division:** Children will begin this topic, learning about multiples and factors.

**Fractions:** Find fractions equivalent to a unit and non-unit fractions. They will compare and order fractions.

### Art: Drawing 'I need Space'

Children will respond to space inspired art. They will be combining drawing and collagraph printmaking to create a futuristic image.



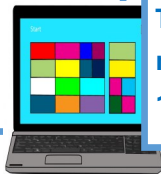
### Geography: What is life like in the Alps?

Children will learn about mountain ranges and why people visit the Alps. They will look at the features that attract tourists; investigate tourism in the local area and recreational land use; comparing the Alps to their own locality.



### Computing: Databases

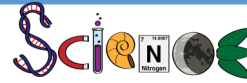
Children will create databases and query existing databases to find information that they are being asked for. By the end of the unit, children would have explored single and multiple table databases.

### Science: Forces

Children will learn about different forces. They will find out about friction, air resistance, water resistance and gravity. They will be planning and completing investigations about air and water resistance.



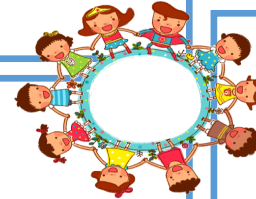
**PE: Gymnastics:** Pupils build strength, control, and flexibility. They create sequences with balances, rolls, and jumps.



**Netball** - pupils develop passing, shooting, and movement skills. They work as a team and apply tactics in small-sided games.

### PSHE: Celebrating Difference

Children will explore the differences and similarities between themselves and others. They will learn about anti-racism and anti-bullying.



### Spanish - The way we look

Pupils will describe appearance, using adjectives and simple sentences. They practise speaking, listening, reading, and writing to describe themselves and others.



### Music: Blues

Children will study blues music. They will sing in tune, using vocal expression to convey meaning. They will explain what a chord is and play the 12-bar blues correctly.

### English:

**Recount letter** - Children will write a letter detailing Hansel's escape from the tower.



**Setting description** -

Children will write a setting description based on the Hansel and Gretel cottage in the woods. They will describe settings, characters and atmosphere.

**Persuasive Leaflet: Visit The Alps.** Children will write a leaflet to encourage visitors to this tourist destination. (Kapow + GS- Unit Guide).



**RE: How do people express their beliefs through worship and caring for others?**



Children will learn about upon how people express these beliefs through worship and caring for others. Pupils will also consider the sensory and emotional responses to worship. How do people feel when they engage in prayer and worship?
