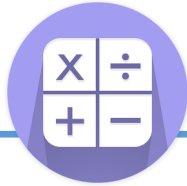

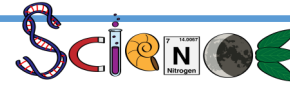
# Year 6 Spring Term 3 on a page



## Maths - Ratio, Algebra, Decimals

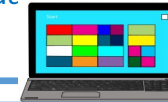
We will start off the year by exploring the relationship between additive and multiplicative ratios. We will then move on to Algebra forming expressions and solving equations. Finally, we will continue to decimals focusing on rounding, and using the four operations.

## Science - Light

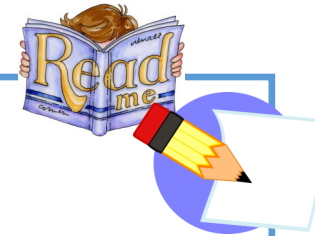


Children will develop an understanding on how the eye works and how light travels. We will also explore how shadows are formed through planning and un-

Computing - **Databases** Children will discover how information can be organised, searched, and sorted, and will create and use their own databases to answer questions and solve problems.



## English - Letters from the Lighthouse- Emma Carroll



This half term we will be building our reading skills through exploring our WWII inspired text. This will focus on: Inference, prediction, and sequencing. The children will also write a narrative using dialogue and a set of instructions linked to surviving an air raid.

## Art - Make my voice heard

(Drawing) This unit focuses on developing skills in using different art styles, exploring effects with tools, understanding and applying chiaroscuro, and creating symbolic and expressive drawings.



## Spanish - Discovering Spain

We will learn about Spain's geography, culture, traditions, and daily life, comparing it to the UK and exploring what makes the country unique.

## PE- Volleyball and Gymnastics

Volleyball- Children will learn key techniques such as serving, passing, and teamwork, building confidence and coordination while playing small-sided games.

Gymnastics- Children will explore and develop their skills in rolling, jumping and balancing.

## RE - Religious and non-religious beliefs about caring for the world



Together, we'll explore what different people believe about caring for our planet and each other. We'll look at our responsibility to protect the environment and learn how various worldviews—such as Judaism, Christianity, Islam, and Humanism—approach this important issue.



History- **WWII** This half term, children will be learning about World War II. They'll explore what life was like during the war, including evacuation, rationing, the Blitz, and how the war affected people in Britain and around the world.



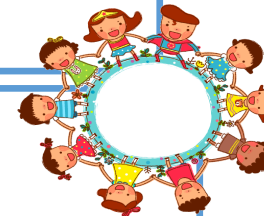
## Music - WWII Songs
