Maths

Multiplication and Division:

Children will learn and use factor pairs. They will also be multiplying two digit and three digit numbers.

Length and Perimeter

Children will find equivalent lengths. They will find and calculate missing lengths in rectilinear shapes.



Art: Drawing

Children will be exploring texture and tone to create a 3D effect. We will also use line to explore texture and proportion.



Geography—Where does our food come from?

We will be looking at our food choices and the effect on the environment as well as what fair trading means. We will be looking at where chocolate comes from and thinking about whether our school dinners are locally sourced.



Music Samba carnival sounds and instruments

(Theme: South America)

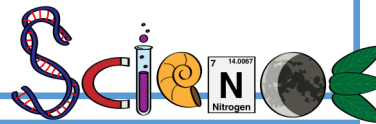
Getting a feel for the music and culture of South America, children are introduced to samba and the sights and sounds of the carnival.

Sound

Children will identify how sounds are made. They will recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear. Children will learn sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.



Computing

Logo- This unit introduces children to programming, focusing on developing their understanding of basic commands. Children will learn to create shapes and letters using instructions that contain ad-



PE

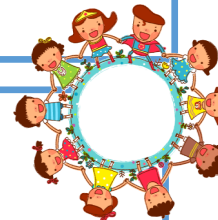
Dance Children think about how to use movement to explore and communicate ideas and issues, their own feelings and thoughts.
