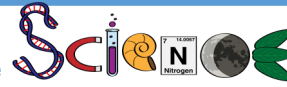


Music - **Theme and Variations:** Children learn how a melody can be changed in different ways to create variations. They listen to examples, explore musical elements such as rhythm, pitch, and

We will be learning to tell the time and use 'time' to talk about other topics like going on holidays, our daily routines and activities and travel .

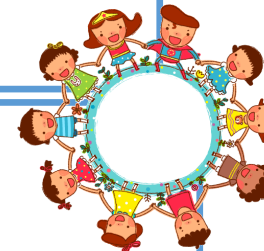
PE- **OAA** (Outdoor and Adventurous Activities): We will work together to solve problems and complete challenges using teamwork and communication.
